What to Bring:

<u>Clothing</u>: Play clothes such as shorts, jeans, t-shirts', and/or underwear, pajamas, *swimsuit, and a jacket. It is not necessary for girls to bring dresses. We trust parents will not send children in clothing with logos that do not honor the Lord or in a style that does not honor the Lord. You may want to send a few extra changes of clothes as the children do get dirty during the day and may want to change into fresh clothing for the evening.

Swimsuit (*modest suit for girls)

The number of pieces is not as important as proper cover of one's body. If the suit is two pieces, the top must overlap the bottom. A T-Shirt & swim shorts should be worn over a bathing suit if there is any doubt that your suit is not modest*.

Personal Items:

Bible	pen/pencil	hairbrush/comb	toothbrush
Soap	shampoo	deodorant	toothpaste
Sunscreen	Chap Stick	towels	washcloths
Pillow	dirty clothes bag	sheets and blanket or sleeping bag	

*And any other personal item your child uses. .

***We also suggest that your child (especially girls) bring a kind of plastic bucket, tray, or bag for carrying their shower items back and forth from the shower to their bunk. Every camper is required to keep all personal items at their bunk. It is not feasible for anyone to leave his or her soap, washcloth, towel, etc. in the shower or bathroom. They can hang damp items on their bunk or on the outside clothesline. Moms and Dads, it would be very helpful if you would prepare your child for being responsible for keeping up with their own personal items. **Please label** <u>ALL</u> items with a permanent marker! If you want your child to bring home everything they came with, you may want to tape into the suitcase a list of everything he/she brought so they can check if off when they repack.

Medications All medications must be labeled and have written instructions. They should be noted on the medical forms and any other instructions given to the camp nurse.

Medical Release Forms for each camper <u>MUST</u> be in Ben Donihoo's hands before campers can load the bus.

WHAT NOT TO BRING:

No electronics – Ex. IPOD, MP3 Players, Cell Phones Money – There is nothing to buy at any time on the trip. Candy/Food – All provided Do not bring shaving cream, water balloons, water guns, silly string, or anything that can be used to harm other people or their property.
